Join a tour of Frederick Douglass' home in Southeast Washington, DC on Wednesday, Aug. 23. The National Park Service notes,

"Douglass spent his life fighting for justice and equality. Born into slavery in 1818, he escaped as a young man and became a leading voice in the abolitionist movement. People everywhere still find inspiration today in his tireless struggle, brilliant words, and inclusive vision of humanity. ... His legacy is preserved ... at Cedar Hill, where he lived his last 17 years."
