It's July, the unofficial close of our OLLI year, leading to a

brief Iull until the Fall class schedule is published and we can anticipate the start of another exciting school year.

This past year was a very good year for OLLI with significant growth in members and a record number of courses. The semester closed with our new series of intensive one week
