

#### <u>Summer</u>

While we don't know yet whether our June and July offerings will be conducted in-person or online (such as ZOOM like our spring session), we are planning to hold classes. The OLLI Board of Directors will be discussing study group format at its April meeting and those who have submitted a proposal with be notified afterwards of the final format. If the summer sessions are conducted remotely, the following support would be provided for Study Group Leaders:

Remote classes can utilize PowerPoints, videos, music, discussion, and guest speakers. Classes can require a book if it can be found for purchase on Amazon or another online retailer. Documents can be sent to class members using an e-mail list OLLI provides.
