

## Register for the February Shorts & Spring 2021!

Registration is OPEN on the OLLI website for the **February Shorts (Feb. 1 - 12)** and **Spring Semester (March 1 - May 7)**. Both sessions will be held online via Zoom. The **Shorts Lottery is January 14** and the **Spring Lottery is February 10**. **Be sure to register** *before* **each session's lottery.** 

## **FEBRUARY SHORTS**

There are two weeks of February Shorts this year: **February 1-5** and **February 8-12**. Each Short course runs for 3, 4, or 5 days during one of the two weeks. The \$75 fee allows you to register for three Shorts before the lottery and then add a fourth after you receive your registration confirmation letter.
